



New Zealand Entry Requirements



New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority (NZeTA)



- All US/Canadian Passport holders require an NZeTA to enter or transit in New Zealand
- The NZeTA allows you to enter New Zealand without out a visa for stays up to 3 months.
- There is a NZ\$17.00 charge for the NZeTA on the free app or NZD\$23 if completed online. You must also pay a NZ\$35.00 International Visitor Conservation and Tourism Levy (IVL), for a total cost of NZ\$52.00 (NZD\$58 online).

- We encourage travelers to apply for an ETA at time of deposit to prevent any unnecessary last minute delays
- In most cases, you will be notified of the result of your application within 10 minutes, however, there occasionally may be a delay of up to 72 hours.

COVID Information

New Zealand no longer requires visitors to be vaccinated.

Please check with your airline or cruise provider as they may still require proof of vaccination. If you have COVID-19 symptoms when you arrive in New Zealand by air, you are encouraged to take a rapid antigen test (RAT).

Should you test positive for COVID during your stay:

- You must register your positive test result [here](#) as soon as possible to connect you to the best care and recovery plan appropriate for you.
- You must self-isolate in your accommodation for 7 days.
- You may leave isolation on day 8.
